The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 29.3 in the identified area, compared to 62.6 for the U.S. as a whole.

Currently, 44.1% of the 25,295 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 17.5%, renter occupied; and 38.4% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.0% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.4% are renter occupied; and 11.6% are vacant. In 2010, there were 23,513 housing units in the area - 44.7% owner occupied, 16.0% renter occupied, and 39.3% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 3.30%. Median home value in the area is \$205,432, compared to a median home value of \$190,791 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.84% annually to \$236,288.

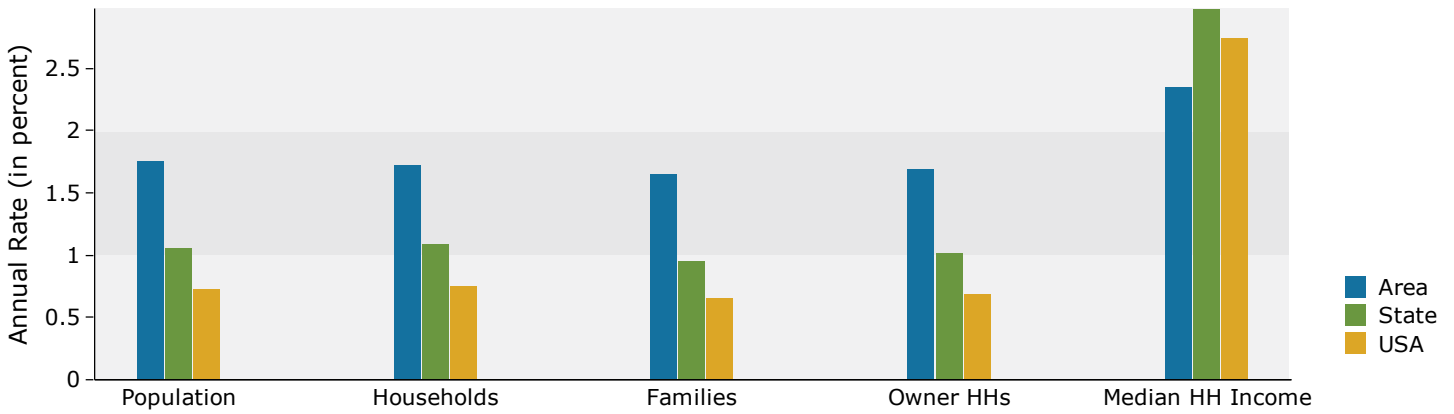

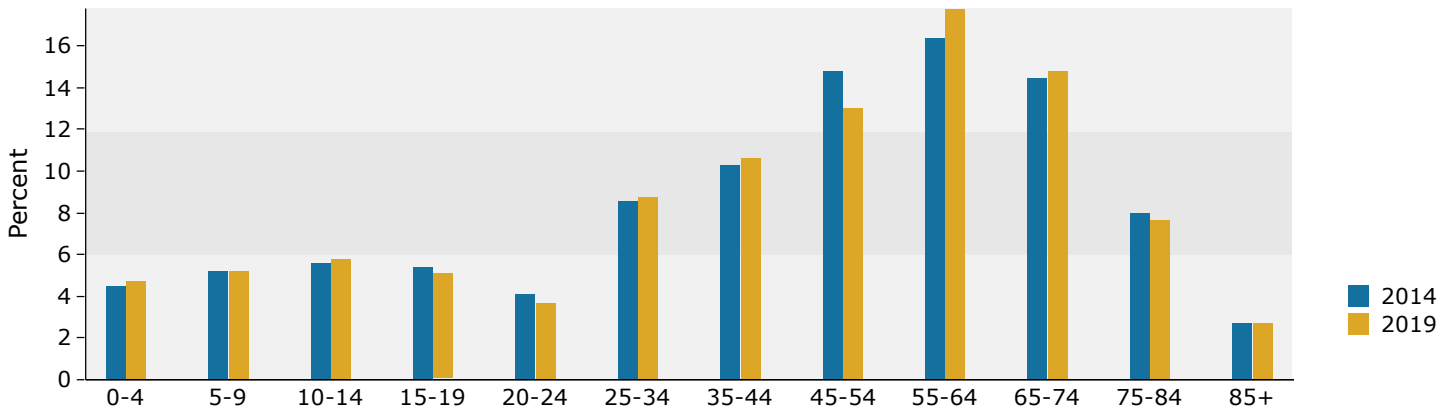

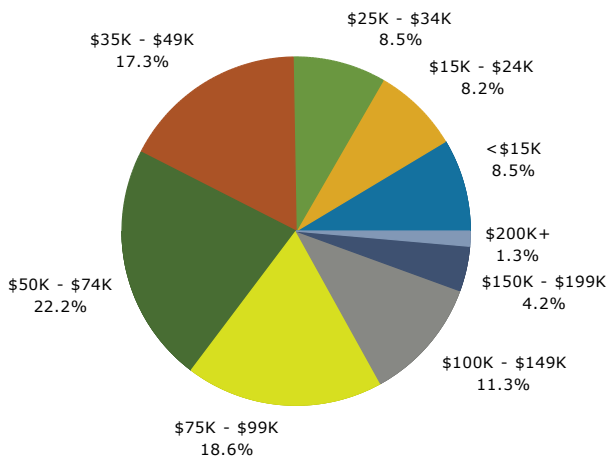

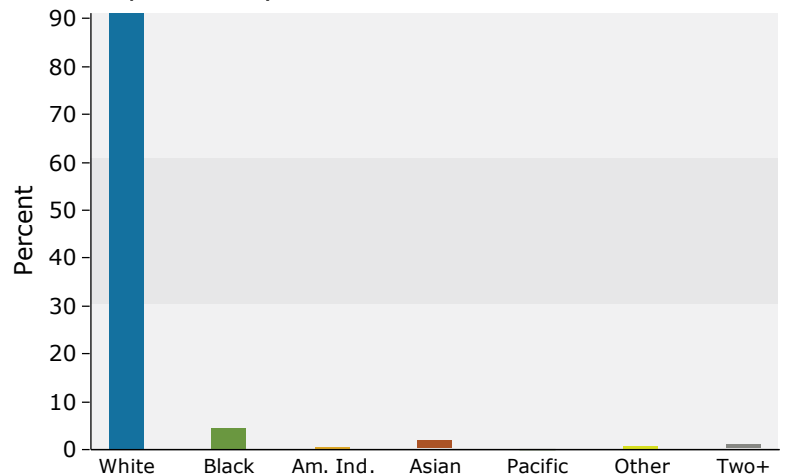
Population by Age

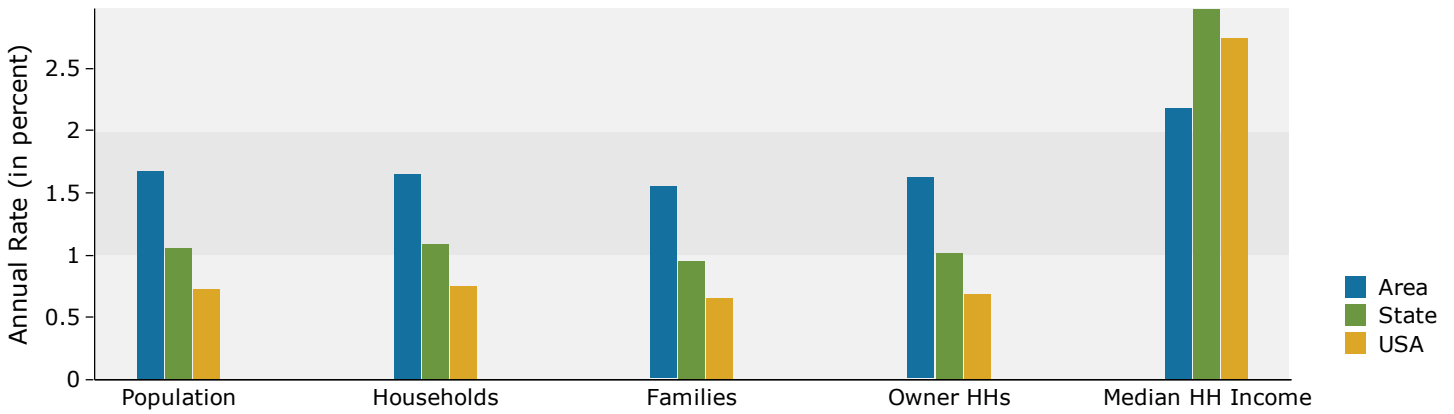

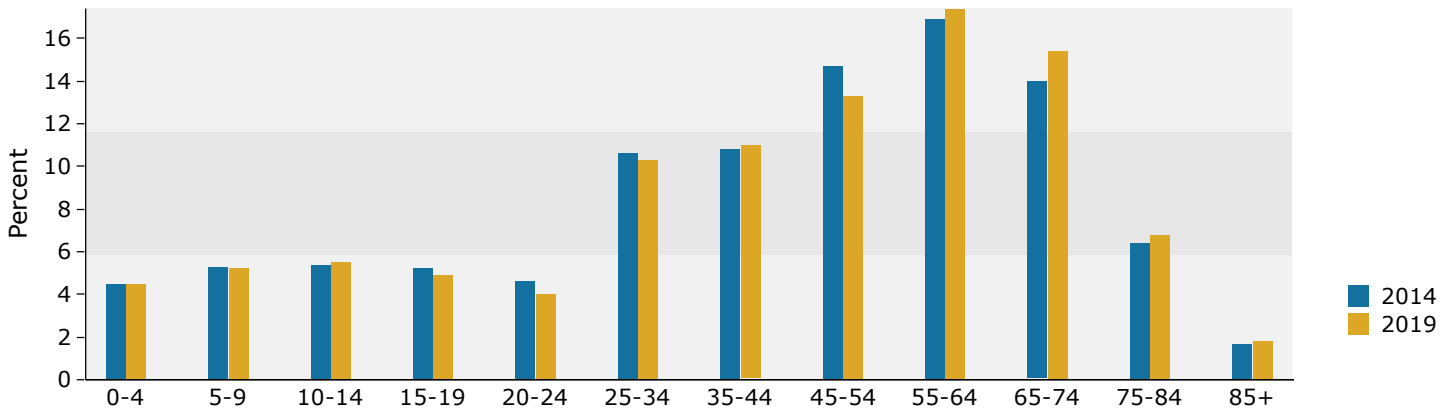

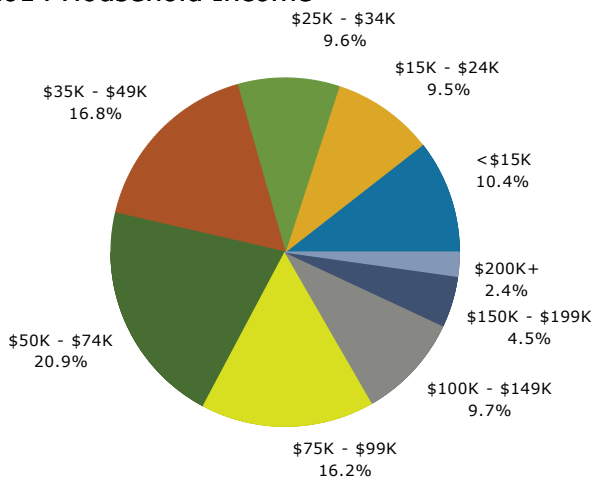
Trends 2014-2019



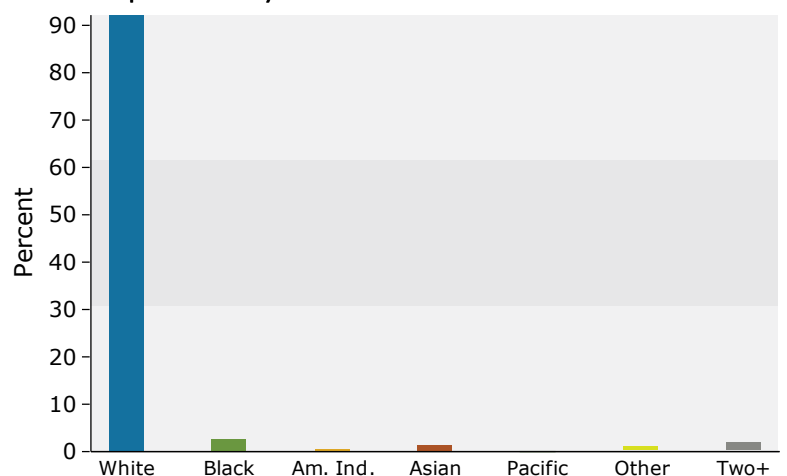
Population by Age

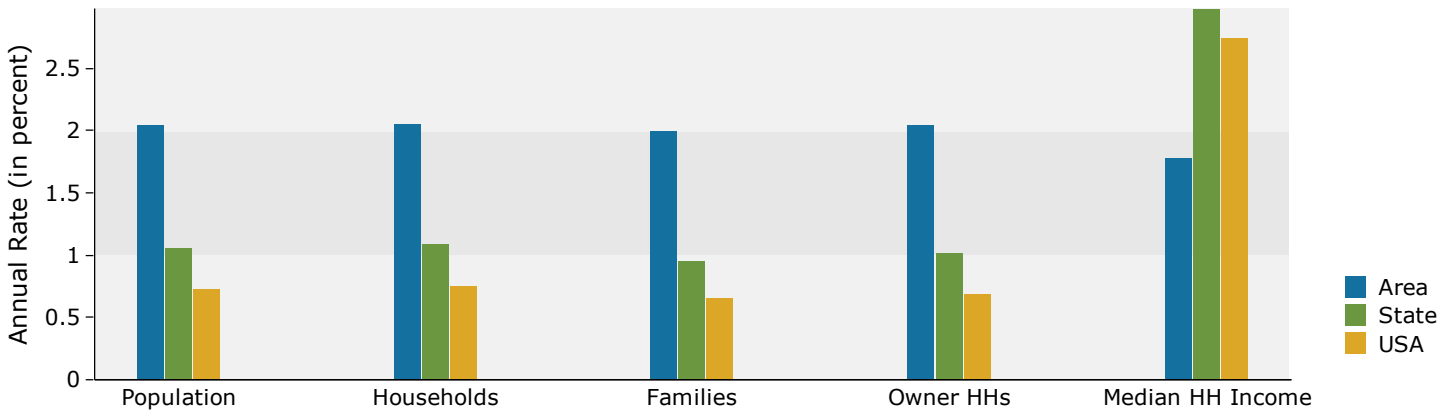

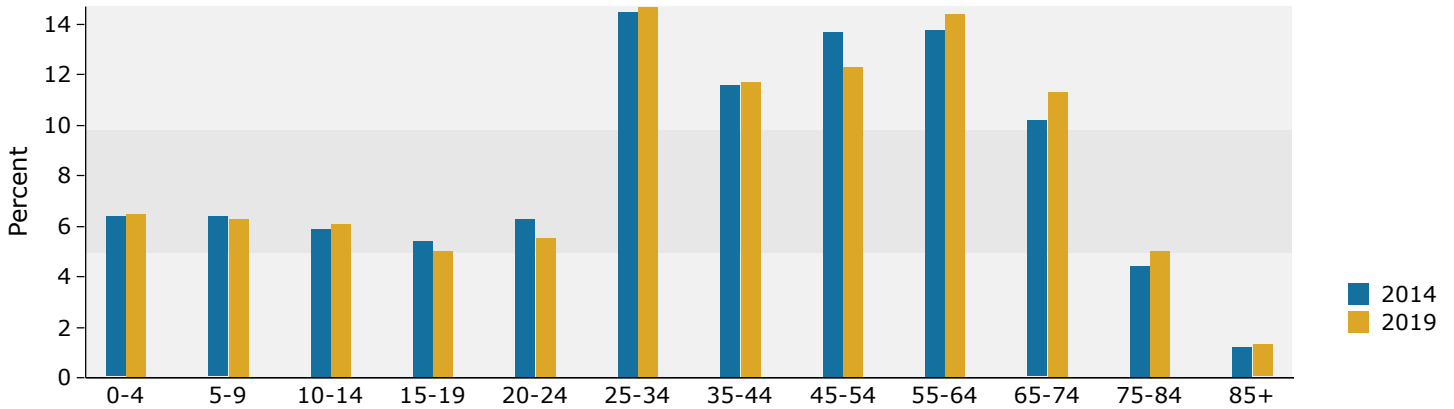
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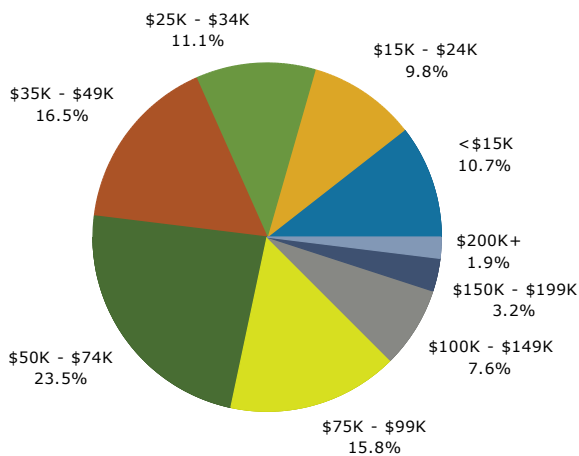
Trends 2014-2019



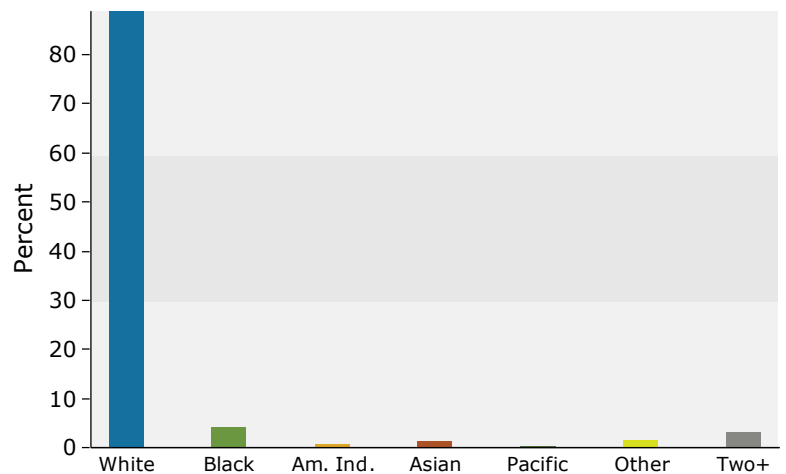
Population by Age
